IMPORTANT

REMINDER: *Create a backup of all of your Google Drive files* (STEAM). If the data gets lost, or your account accidentally gets deleted, you will want to have a backup. *This is important because, if you have STEAM files and you don't have a backup, you may have to start over if something happens to your online files. You can download a copy to your PC, a flash drive, a CD, another cloud storage place, or an external hard drive.

2017 SENIORS: your accounts will be **deleted** this summer. If you have college, testing, and or scholarship information you need to keep, please take 10 minutes and forward the e-mails to another account, change your email address with the colleges, and download any files you want to keep.

STEAM

The yearly STEAM reflections are part of the students' senior projects and become part of each student's senior project portfolio, which is required for graduation. Students are given time to work on these in class. If they need additional time, they should work on them on their own. There are teachers available and willing to help your students. All of the information about STEAM can be found on the STEAM page of the school website at sfhscougars.com. Anyone with questions or concerns is welcome to come in and ask. Students who write these reflections each year score higher on the SAT and report that they are prepared for college and career writing.

1. STEAM will open for **summer submissions June 2**.
2. It will remain open indefinitely for 14-15, 15-16, and 16-17 school year submissions.
3. Scoring will take place at the end of the summer.
4. If your child is behind, or needs to make corrections, please encourage them to do so this summer.
5. For a successful submission, we recommend that your child read all instructions and rubrics carefully before submitting.
6. Information, resources, rubrics and writing guides are available on [STEAM](#) page of the school website. The rubrics change slightly from year to year in response to students' needs, but the basic requirements remain the same.

The year has flown by. The Imagine Academy Program is off to a great start. This year, there were 42 Microsoft Office Certifications earned. Students who certified received a certificate and an 8 GB flash drive. **Congratulations students**. You should be very proud of your accomplishments. These certification tests are provided free through the Microsoft Imagine Academy. The cost of these tests normally run around \$125 each. The cost savings to students for these certifications is approximately \$5250. The digital skills students learn will be invaluable to them in our technological world.

Two of our students, Connor Bergmans and Bilee Abegglen, placed 1st and 2nd respectively in the state in the Microsoft Excel 2013

Certification Test. Three places are considered in each of the certification test areas. The **first place** person for each has the opportunity to compete at the **National Championship Event**. Connar received a perfect score on the Excel Certification test. Brilee was close behind. The announcement is below.

Because of the exceptionally high score you received on your Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Excel 2013 exam, you have been **named your State's Champion** and selected to compete in Certiport's 2017 Microsoft Office Specialist U.S. National Championship at the Hilton Orlando Lake Buena Vista in Orlando, FL, June 20-22, 2017.

Next year, students will have the opportunity to certify in Microsoft Office 2016.
