SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

A family or business can participate in providing scholarships to the graduating seniors at SFHS

THERE ARE 5 TYPES AVAILABLE:

1. **One time only** -
 - (Given once for any amount you choose)
2. **Contributing** -
 - (This fund is contributed to yearly and given accordingly)
3. **Self-Depleting** -
 - (This is a one time contribution of any size. The scholarship is given each year at a set amount until there are no longer funds available)
4. **Permanent** -
 - (This scholarship requires a minimum \$10,000 start. We guarantee the rate of return for a set number of years depending upon the size of the contribution)
5. **Share** -
 - (This scholarship is offered to all incoming freshmen as they start high school. There is a \$50 entry fee and then they have four years to earn \$50 per year giving them a total of \$250. SFEF will match their share if completed by May 1 of their senior year giving them \$500.)

All scholarships can be tailored to family wishes or business demands. The recipient can be selected with or without family participation and in whatever career field you choose.
