The SFEF is a 501 © 3 non-profit service organization serving the needs of students and faculty in southern Fremont County.

In May of 2007, the Foundation gave 14 scholarships totaling 6,600. While this is a good start, we would like to do more with your help.

EXPLANATION

- 1. ONE TIME ONLY**—The amount given is a one-time event.
- 2. CONTRIBUTING**—This fund is contributed to each year at a set amount until it is gone.
- 3. SELF DEPLETING**—There is a one-time contribution made of any size and the scholarship is given each year at a set amount until it is gone.
- 4. PERMANENT**—This scholarship requires a minimum \$10,000 to start. The Foundation offers a guaranteed rate of return providing a wonderful gift for someone each year.
- 5. SHARE**—This scholarship is offered to all incoming freshmen as they start high school. There is a \$50 entry fee and then they have four years to earn \$50 per year giving them a total of \$250. SFEF will match their share if completed by May 1 of their senior year giving them \$500.
